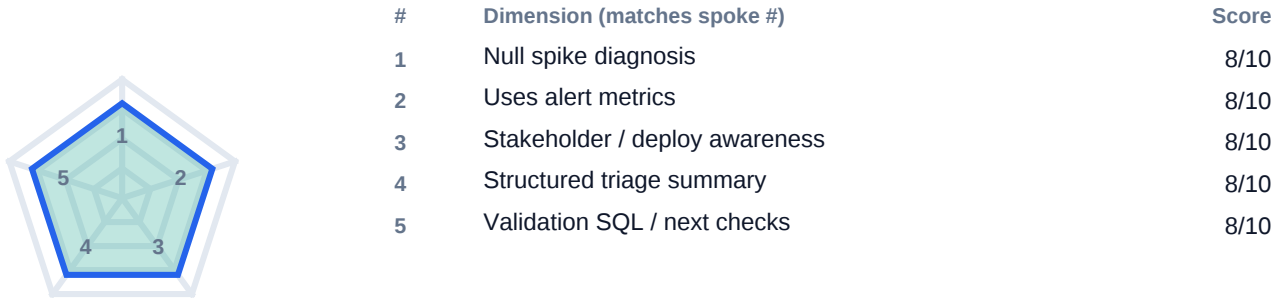

1. Likely cause of the spike

The recent deploy to checkout-api (2026?07?04) changed the default value for missing geo?location from an empty string to NULL. This likely introduced a large number of NULL values into `shipping\_country\_code` overnight as orders were processed by the new API.

3. Is a recent deploy suspect?

Yes. The checkout?api change is the most plausible source. The rollback or a fix to revert the default to an empty string (or a sentinel value) should be applied immediately to prevent further data quality issues.
