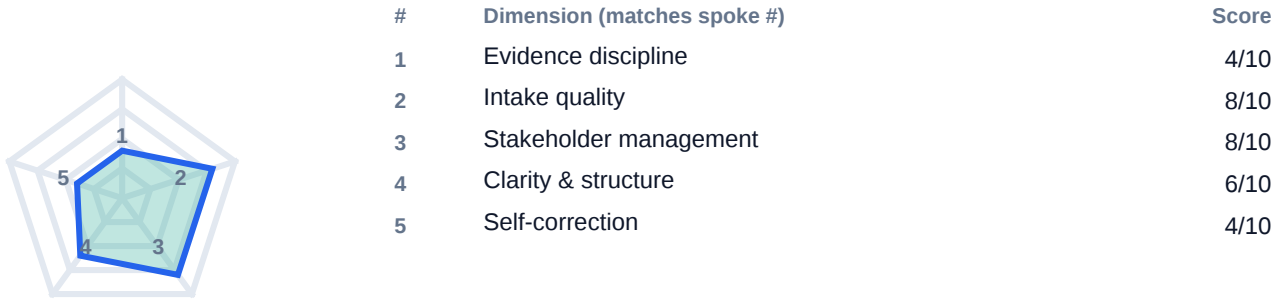

Developing: Mixed signals-useful in places, but the rubric sees gaps in verification depth, intake, or pressure handling. (2 dimension(s) in the critical band, 1 in the watch band-see focus areas.)

Interpretation

Run finished with status "ended." The scorecard reflects messages saved in the transcript. The sim used its full agent turn budget without detecting scenario closure - treated as a failure to close, not a successful ending.

BRIGHT SPOTS (RUBRIC)

- + Intake & questions: Specific, high-signal questions and definitions; good ambiguity reduction.
- + Stakeholder / exec pressure: Good partnership under pressure: bounded updates, actionable scripts, and steady tone.

RUBRIC GAPS

- Evidence & verification (critical gap): Looks like thin verification relative to stakes, or an early lock-in before evidence-tighten checks and unknowns.
- Clarity & structure (priority watch): Understandable, but structure could be tighter (bullets, explicit asks, timeboxes). At 3/5 this is still a visible gap versus top-tier crisis handling-tighten before it becomes the thread's weak link under exec pressure.
- Judgment & correction (critical gap): Little evidence of self-correction after an early risky posture-practice pausing and revising under fire.
